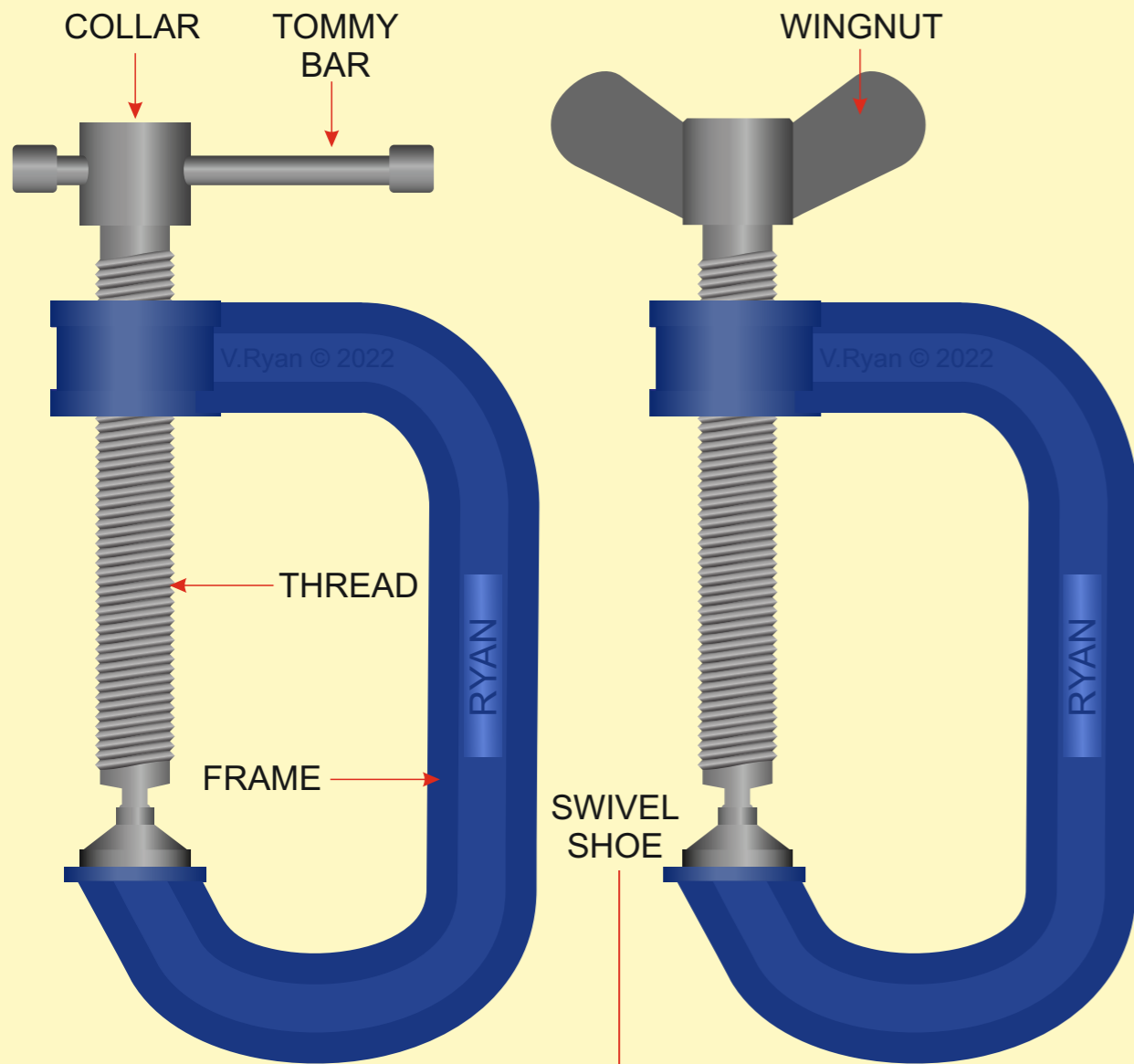
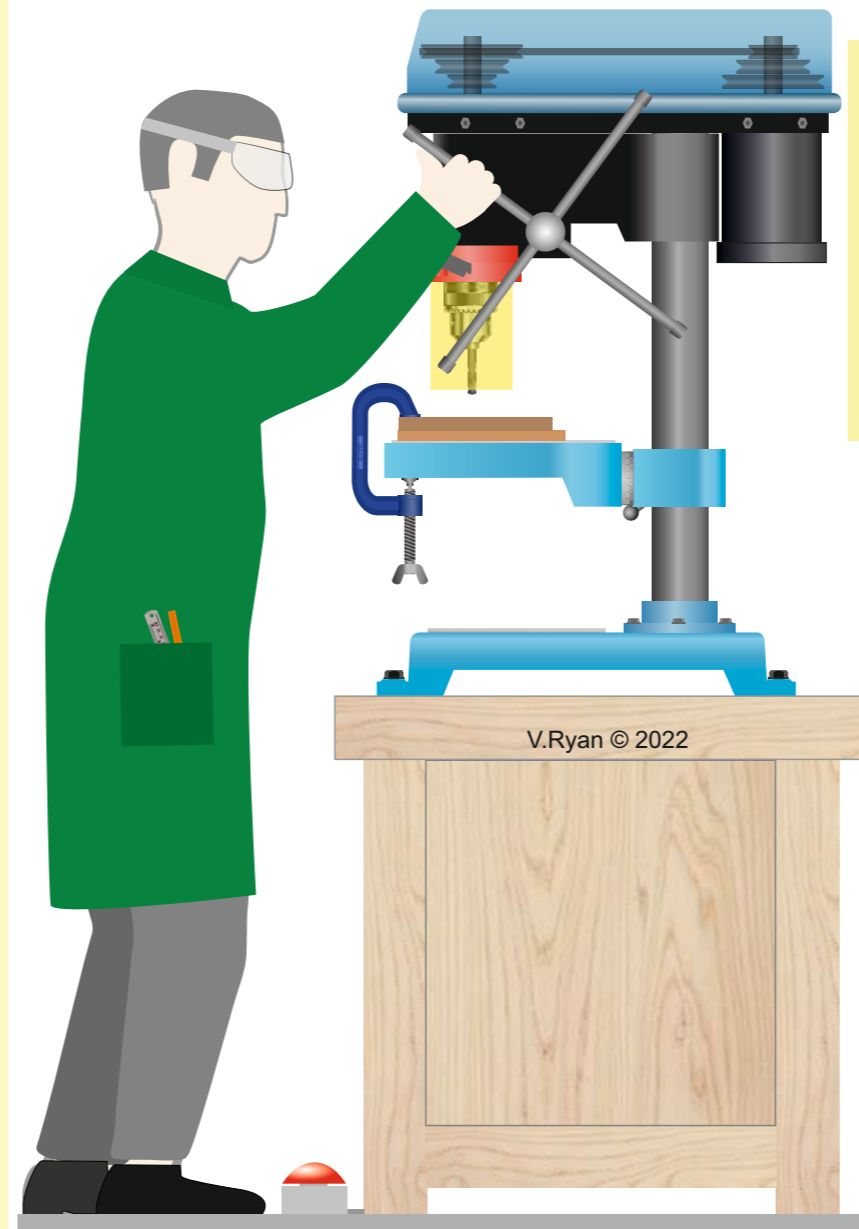
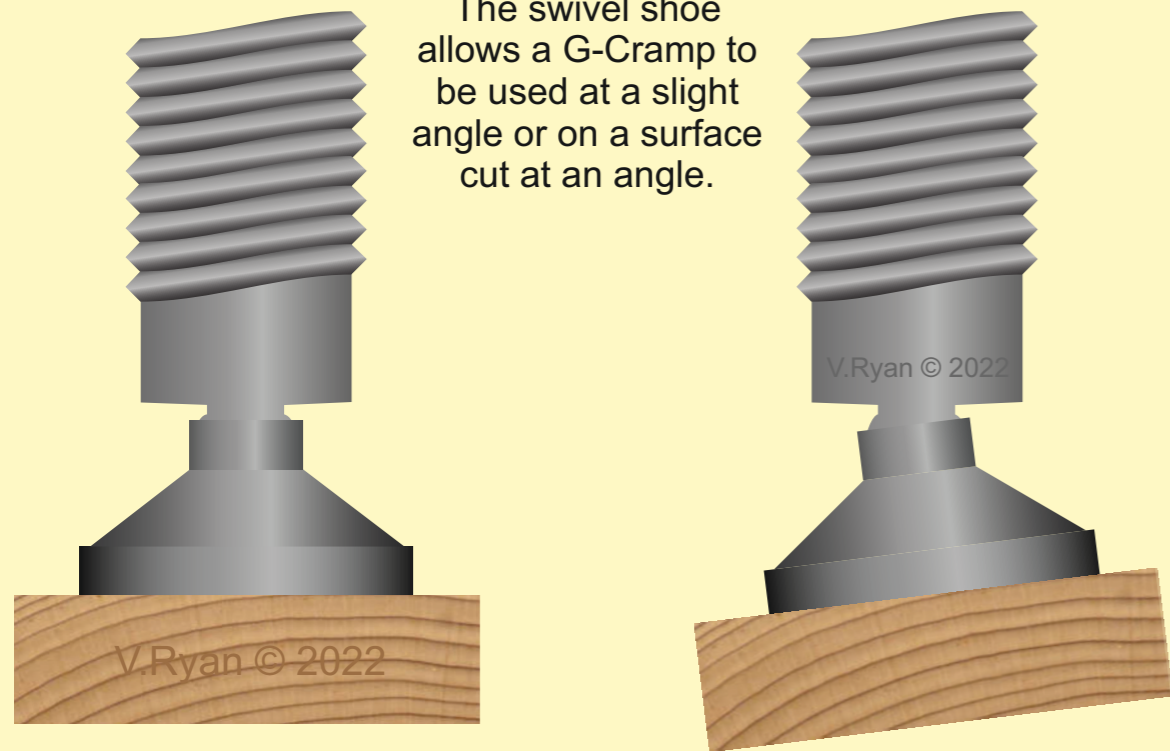


THE G CRAMP (G-CRAMP)



The swivel shoe allows a G-Cramp to be used at a slight angle or on a surface cut at an angle.



G Cramps are an essential workshop tool. They are supplied in a range of sizes and are often used to clamp work securely to a surface/workbench top. They can also be used to hold parts together, when gluing. The clamp is tightened by turning the small tommy bar, which turns the threaded rod. Some G Cramps have a wingnut, making it easier to turn by hand. However, if a tommy bar is used, more pressure can be applied to the thread, tightening the clamp even further.
