


This normally appears on packaging and reminds the customer that the product inside is fragile. BUT - remember, a fragile toy is a dangerous one.




#### THIS WAY UP


This symbol is normally found on packaging. It states which way up the package and the product inside it should be stored.

## TESTED BRITISH STANDARDS


Tested for safety to British Safety Standards. This symbol means that the product has been tested and passed as safe by the British Standards Institute.



The symbol opposite is placed above important information, usually on the packaging. It may be next to information that explains how the product should be used.
